Travel Information

Driving directions to Hilton Garden Inn (Bothell)

7. Take exit 26 toward Bothell (0.4 miles)
8. Turn left onto WA-527 S/Bothell Everett Hwy, continue to follow Bothell Everett Hwy (0.2 miles)
9. Turn right (197 ft.)
10. Hilton Garden Inn (22600 Bothell Everett Hwy, Bothell, WA 98021) will be on the left
