



COVID Notes	Current COVID restrictions at Boeing have been relaxed somewhat, so indoor masking is not required but recommended. Vaccinations are not required for on-site access. The meeting venue was chosen to meet COVID restrictions at the time (i.e., space large enough to accommodate the meeting personnel with required social distancing). As the COVID situation is dynamic, it is planned to keep this venue in case any restrictions are re-instated.

Parking as indicated above (lots 8 or 9). The 2-25/2-22 buildings are located at a high traffic intersection. Use the pedestrian tunnels to safety cross E Marginal Way from the parking lots to the 2-25/2-22 buildings.

Go to the 2-25 lobby, meet a Boeing representative to receive your badge and be escorted to the 2-22 meeting location. There is no reception service at the 2-25 lobby.

Occasionally there is aircraft movement from Plant 2 to North Boeing Field during the middle of the night. Your host will remind you of the specific parking restrictions and hazards in advance.

Be aware of construction actives in or around the building. Follow all posted signage and do not enter any construction zones.
