Activity Scope

The IPS Subcommittee has developed an industry roadmap for defining the Internet Protocol Suite for Aeronautical Safety Services, including airborne, ground-based, and space-based communication systems. It is coordinating with aviation Standards Development Organizations (SDOs), Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs), and others with an interest. This activity is authorized by APIM 15-004 and APIM 15-004A (draft).

Meeting Objectives

IPS Subcommittee Meeting in Cocoa Beach

The purpose of this meeting is to initiate work on the following document:

ARINC Project Paper 858: *Internet Protocol Suite (IPS) for Aeronautical Safety Services - Technical Requirements.*

Topics of discussion are as follows:

- ATN/IPS Architectures Air and Ground
- Core Functions
- Mobility Considerations
- Redundancy Considerations
- Network and Data Security
- Interfaces and Convergence Functions
- Airborne Application Data Considerations
- Airborne Implementation Options
- Support for legacy aircraft equipped with ACARS and ATN/OSI
- Transition phase during which ACARS, ATN/OSI, and IPS will co-exist
- ATN/IPS Standardization timelines with ICAO, RTCA, EUROCAE, etc.

The goal of this meeting is to reach consensus on the overall scope of ARINC Project Paper 858.

This work package is pending approval of APIM 15-004A by the AEEC Executive Committee.

Travel Information

Hotel Directions and Transportation

The Hilton Cocoa Beach Oceanfront Hotel is located about 45 miles from the Orlando, Florida Airport. A rental car or a van service is recommended.

Orlando International Airport (MCO)

Distance from hotel: 45 miles

Drive time: 45 minutes

Directions: Take SR 528 East (Bee Line) for 40 miles until it becomes A1A South at Port Canaveral. Go 5 miles on A1A South through Cape Canaveral and into Cocoa

Beach. The Hilton hotel is located 1 mile south of Ron Jon's on the left.

Note: SR 528 is a toll road. Plan on having cash or SunPass in your rental car.

Melbourne International (MLB)

Distance from hotel: 25 miles

Drive time: 40 minutes

Directions: Turn left onto NASA Blvd to US 1; turn left onto US 1 North to SR 404 (Pineda Causeway). Turn right onto 404 East to Hwy A1A; turn left onto A1A North and go 8 miles. The Hilton Cocoa Beach is located on the right side of the road.
