Travel Information

Calgary is served by Calgary International Airport (YYC) approximately 17 km northeast of the city center.

From Calgary International Airport (YYC):

By Shuttle: Travel time is approximately 20 minutes. Reservations must be made directly with the hotel in advance, and the charge is CAD \$5.00 per trip. See Attachment 1.

By Taxi: Travel time is approximately 20 minutes, and the fare will be CAD \$20-40.

By Uber: Travel time is approximately 20 minutes, and the fare will be approximately CAD \$10-30.

Other Information

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police established a post in Calgary in 1875, although the surrounding area had been inhabited by native peoples for centuries. Today it is Canada's fourth largest city, with a population of approximately 1.3 million. It is a prosperous business hub dominated by oil, gas, and mining. Attractions include the Calgary Tower, National Music Centre, Olympic Park, and Calgary Stampede Grounds.
