# Instructions ARINC Registration:

You must register with ARINC to obtain proper badging and ensure your seating. Please notify ARINC Industry Activities of your intention to attend by registering online. The attendance fee is \$600 per individual. AEEC • AMC • FSEMC Members, Corporate Sponsors, and Invited Speakers are exempt from attendance fees. IATA Member Airlines that are not AEEC • AMC • FSEMC Members are extended a discounted attendance fee of \$300 per individual. The registration site provides details. Pre-registration will close on Friday May 13, 2016. All participants who have not pre-registered by this date will be required to register on site.

Travel Informaton	The Hilton Munich Park Hotel is located 35 kilometers from the Munich International Airport.				
	From Munich International Airport (MUC):				
	<b>By Taxi:</b> Travel time is approximately 30 minutes and the fare will be in the range of $\notin$ 50.				
	<b>By Metro:</b> Train and subway service is also available from the airport. Take the train from the airport to the Munich main train station. Then take the tram and disembark at the Tivoli Strasse stop, and the hotel will be a five-minute walk. The fare will be approximately $\leq 20$ .				
	Once you have arrived, no additional transportation will be required, as all EFB activities will be held at the hotel.				
Other Information	Munich is a popular tourist destination in Germany. It offers cultural attractions such as the Munich Concert Hall, BMW Museum, Hofbräuhaus, and Olympic Center.
