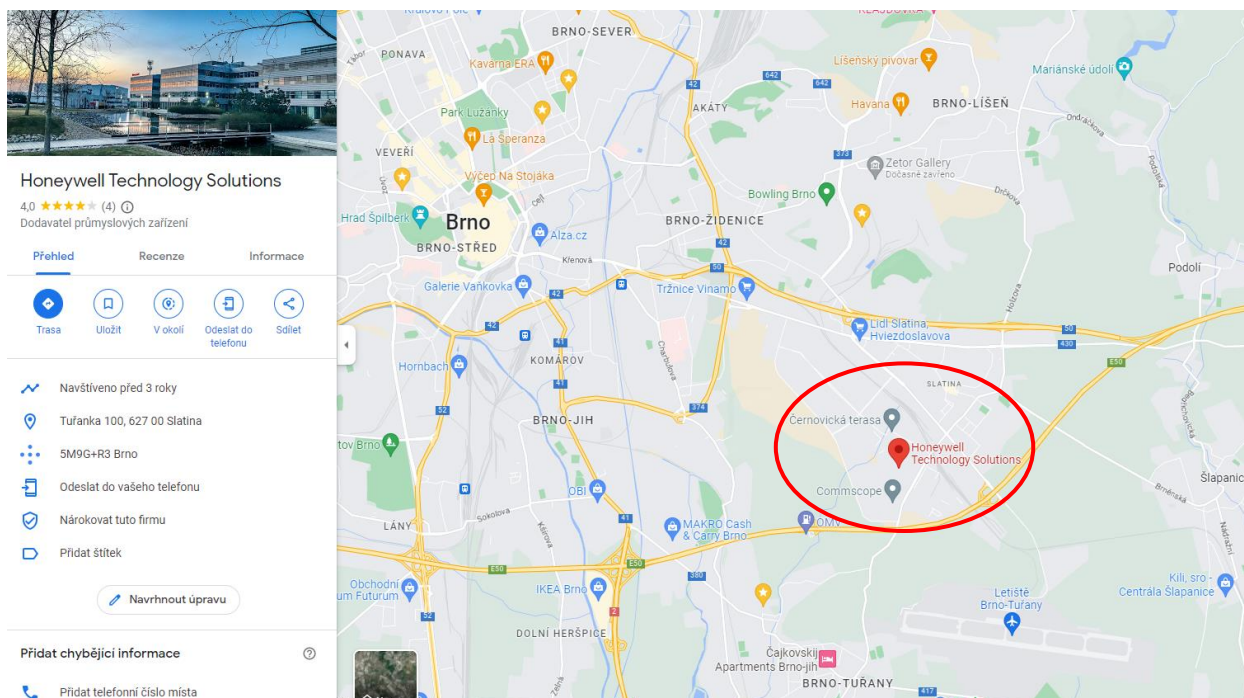

# Getting to Brno

## Vienna airport

### By train from Vienna

<https://www.cd.cz/en/>

Train from Vienna Airport train station (Flughafen Wien) to Brno Main Train station.

In this case, you need to change at Vienna Hauptbahnhof (Vienna Main Train station). The train goes every 2 hours and it takes approximately 2 hours. You can purchase the train ticket online at [Eshop | České dráhy](#) (First Minute Europe Ticket from 14€), or in kiosks at the Airport train station.

### By bus from Vienna

Yellow RegioJet bus from Vienna airport directly to Brno. There is no ticket office at the airport. You can buy your ticket in advance (<https://regiojet.com/>) and pay by credit card.

**NOTE:** There are also other transport companies that operate buses from Vienna to Brno (for example FlixBus, Tourbus, Eurolines), but they usually do not leave directly from the airports, and arrive at another bus station in Brno called Zvonařka.

### By train from Prague

Train from Prague Main Train station to Brno Main Train station.

In this case, you need to take **first the city shuttle bus** (Airport Express) to get from the airport to the center and then take the underground (metro) to get to the train station (ask at the info desk at the airport for details).

### By bus from Prague

Yellow RegioJet bus from Prague airport with a bus change at the Main Bus Station (Florenc) in Prague center. There is a RegioJet ticket office at Terminal 1.

**NOTE:** There are also other transport companies that operate buses from Prague to Brno (for example Tourbus, Eurolines), but they usually do not leave directly from the airports, and arrive at another bus station in Brno called Zvonařka.

## **Brno airport**

The airport is located southeast of the city, about two kilometers from the Honeywell facility. However, very limited international flights arrive to Brno – Ryanair from London Stansted and Milano Bergamo.

### **Public transport – Bus (Brno)**

Brno Airport is reachable by public transport, during day (bus E76) and night (bus N89). During the day, bus E76 leaves every 60 minutes from the airport (Letiště Tuřany) to the Main Train station (Hlavní Nádraží). Bus N89 departs every 60 minutes during the night. The journey to the Main Train station takes about 20 minutes. The price of a ticket is 25 CZK for adults and can be purchased at the terminal or by using contactless credit card in the bus.

To get to Honeywell from the Brno Airport take bus E76 to stop “Řípská” and change to bus 77 to stop “Černovická terasa II”.

## Getting to Honeywell from the city center

### **Public transport**

Brno offers a well organized system of public transport. However, there is no direct line from the city center to the Honeywell premises. You need to walk a little, or transfer once.

To get to Honeywell, take **bus no. 77 to stop "Černovická terasa I"**. To get to the bus from your hotel please use the "public transport" feature in Google maps – it works reliably in Brno. The bus no. 77 runs every 15 minutes and it takes about 25-30 minutes to get to Honeywell (including walking/transfer).

### **Taxi/Uber**

Taxi or Uber works well in Brno. It takes about 15 minutes to get to Honeywell from the city center.

### **Rental car**

**We strongly discourage you from renting a car in Brno.** Parking in the city center is hard, peak traffic is usually very bad. However, parking at Honeywell is possible if needed – please contact Barbora Salandova (+420 604 286 399) for parking reservation arrangements.
