The NDB Subcommittee will review proposals for incorporation into the Navigation Data Base Standard, draft Supplement 21 to ARINC Specification 424 or ARINC Project Paper 424A.

Some of the issues to be addressed are:

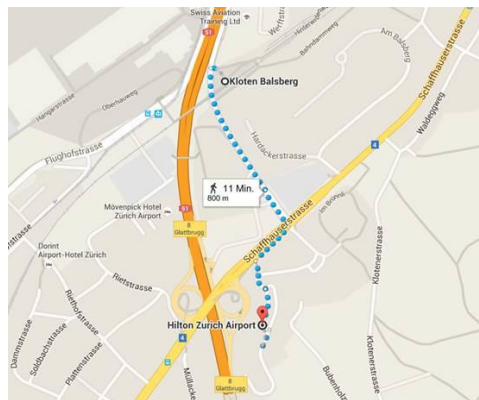
1. Action Team to report on Multiple IF Approach Coding. Steve Moody, Action Team leader.
2. Universal Avionics to provide a Working Paper or Discussion Paper on Level of Service Flag.
3. Airbus to provide a proposal on VFR Route Coding.
4. Data Base suppliers to advise when they will support XML.
5. Jeppesen to provide update to Section 5.290 and 5.291.
6. Review ARINC 424A UML Model.

## Travel Information

A complimentary shuttle bus runs from the airport to the Hilton Zurich Airport Hotel and back. The service operates between 5:30am and 11:10pm and the shuttle runs every 20 minutes during peak times and 30 minutes off peak. The bus leaves from the airport arrivals level between Terminals 1 and 2 and the journey takes approximately 5 minutes.

From Zurich Main Station:
