	The NDB Subcommittee will review proposals for incorporation into the Navigation Data Base Standard, draft Supplement 23 to ARINC Specification 424.		
	Some of the issues to be addressed are:		
	 Airbus is to provide an updated proposal on Initial Missed Approach Leg with Immediate Turn. Database suppliers are to provide test data to FMS manufactures (Working Paper 8, Reference 17-161/NDT-173). Universal Avionics accepted the action item to review Chapter 4 and 		
	update Notes 1 and 2, as appropriate, to the non-standard sorting		
	 sequence. FMS manufactures are to research and provide feedback to Lufthansa System FlightNav: if the recommended Navaid goes away, what will the FMS do with it? (Working Paper 12, Reference 18-094/NDT-176) 		
	 4. AeroNavData is to research and develop a proposal on Section 5.300 to determine if it is necessary (Working Paper 20, Reference 18-094/NDT-176). 		
	 MITRE accepted the action to lead the effort in drafting a proposal based on XML ALT DESC Code G Description (Attachment 12 to Reference 19-064/NDT-179) discussion. 		
	6. Jeppesen to provide a proposal on Baro-VNAV (Attachment 14 to Reference 19-064/NDT-179).		
	7. Boeing to lead an action team in developing a mature proposal to add a new continuation record for Airport SID/STAR/Approach Name for the textual representation of the SID/STAR/Approach.		
	8. MITRE and GE Aviation accepted the action to develop a discussion paper for the next meeting on how to handle future XML 424 legacy issues.
