Garmin is proposing to add the office of primary responsibility (OPR) to SIDs/STARs/Approaches

1.0 INTRODUCTION/ BACKGROUND

The Type 1 database suppliers send us the procedures from the civilian and military AIPs in the same NavDB. For example, the King Salmon (PAKN) airport has two ILS procedures to RW12; one which has a FAA OPR and the other has a US Air Force (USAF) OPR.

This will be sent to us in the ARINC 424 database without any indication of which one is published in the civilian versus military AIP, with the military AIP coming with a built-in expectation of limited access.

5.### Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR)

Definition/Description: The Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) indicates if the procedure was sourced in the civilian or military aeronautical information publication (AIP). The procedures from the military may be sourced in a separate AIP with the expectation that they should only be flown by military aircraft.

Source/Content: The OPR is derived from official government source. The OPR shall be packed in at least one Primary Extension record per procedure. If the Primary Extension record is output more than once on a procedure, the OPR value shall always be the same value.
