



## Welcome to St. Louis

The National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) is honored to host the 2022 ARINC NDB Conference at the T-REX building (911 Washington Ave, St. Louis, MO 63101) in downtown St. Louis, Missouri. The T-REX is a non-profit innovation, entrepreneur and workforce development organization and is a proud partner of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency. We will be meeting in NGA's Moon Shot Lab (MSL) on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

### Virtual Meeting Info:

- For those attending virtually, or for those who would like to dial in to the meeting electronically while at the T-REX, please see the attached WebEx virtual meeting info.

### Local Services and Parking:

- It is recommended that you stay in one of the hotels within walking distance from the T-REX, and utilize your hotel's parking facilities.
- Parking is available around the T-REX, but it is limited and will cost at least an additional \$10/day. It is not recommended to use the metered parking on the streets as most of these have a 2-hour limit and cost approximately \$2/hour. You will be ticketed for expired meters. Please see the included information sheet for parking options around the T-REX.
- There are numerous restaurants and coffee shops within a close walking distance from the T-REX. Please see the included information regarding local services.

### Building Info:

- When you enter the T-REX building, proceed to the center of the main floor lobby and sign in with the information desk. Tell them you are attending the ARINC NDB Conference.
- Once you exit the elevator on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, the main entrance to the MSL will be right in front of you.
- There is no formal building security, however the doors to the MSL are keypad controlled. Someone at the reception desk in the MSL will let you in Tuesday morning.

### Building Amenities:

- The MSL has a kitchen with many amenities. There will be a refrigerator for storing food and drinks if desired, along with ice and water available. A Keurig coffee machine is also available, but with a limited selection of K-cups and coffee mugs. It is recommended you bring your own insulated water bottle and/or coffee cup. If you utilize the provided K-cups, sugar, and creamer, please leave a donation in the "tip jar."
- Power strips will be available for charging laptop computers and mobile phones at each desk. The Wi-Fi network information will be provided upon arrival. There are no restrictions on the use of personal electronic devices.
