Meeting Objectives

The intent of the SCQ Working Group is to initiate discussion to alternative means of continuing qualification and validation of FSTDs – and share and promote new ideas and ways of optimizing regular testing and checking methods. We invite your organization to participate in this "idea generation" activity to ensure we consider ideas from across the industry.

The meeting will delve into improving recurrent qualification evaluations outside of the QTG processes. The group's discussions will result in several points:

- The activity will produce a standard or set of guidance for an alternate means of compliance for the continuing evaluation of FSTDs.
- Guidance Material for Configuration Control for Software (Simulator Systems).
- Recommendations for recurrent qualification testing methodologies.
